## **AUCC UNDER12 SIDE VERSUS SYDNEY TOURING SIDE**

Over the break the club fielded an Under12 team to play against a touring side from the Pirates club in Ryde Hunters Hill in Sydney. The format was Twenty20. Pirates are a similar size club to AUCC so the contest would be an interesting comparison of junior cricket between the 2 countries. We decided to adopt proper international T20 rules for the game with fielding restrictions and front foot no-balls being a "free hit". Our players took a short while to get used to T20 game format and in the first game, we posted mediocre 116/8 off our 20 overs built mostly around a 32no from George Witana and a few lusty late blows from Kent Fletcher, Sam Davison and Jack Collins. We then bowled brilliantly to restrict them to 82 off their 20. The highlight of which was front foot no-balls from George and Vihingum Siriwardane, both of which were followed up by Yorkers uprooting the middle stump on the free hit!!!

In the 2nd game, our lads had a bit more of an idea and the top order fired brilliantly. We posted 139/6, with George and Finn Allen retiring and contributions from all the top order. The bowling was spot on again and we restricted them to 104 for a comprehensive victory with everyone contributing and sticking to the game plan while being backed up in the field. All in all a fantastic day thoroughly enjoyed by our guests who were left very impressed by our facility, talent and the spirit of the lads.

Two years ago Peter was invited by the organizers of the Australian State Over 60's Championships to take an Auckland team over to compete in the Championships in Tasmania.

We did go and it was fantastic – lovely people and a great competition with play ideally suited to older players who remember when the game was played in great spirit and when sledging was what you did behind a bunch of huskies. In November of last year, we returned to the Championships, this time played in Canberra. Again we had a fantastic trip and met up with some great teams. Over 60s cricket is as competitive as we can make it within the limitations of age, agility and memory but be assured it is great fun and a good standard of cricket with great friendship on and off the field.

Subsequently, Andrew Eade asked Peter to host the Inaugural New Zealand Over 60's

In association with the Auckland Cricket Association and the North Shore Cricket Club, we are therefore hosting the Inaugural Over 60's Cricket Tournament in Devonport, Auckland between Sunday 6 March and Thursday 10th March (inclusive) of this year- so only a few weeks away.

Over 60s cricket is very popular in England and Australia. The Australian Championship in Canberra featured 24 teams-some of which had been selected! The composite Auckland Over 60s finished 1st equal in the 2nd Division in 2009 and 2nd in the Second Division in 2010. The team is already entered for the 2011 Championship which is to be played in Armidale, New South Wales this coming November.

Two teams are coming from New South Wales for the week. The Auckland Cricket Society and University Fingletoads are putting teams together, the Karaka Stallions

are starters and there is a strong rumour that a team from Northland will be taking part. We are looking to recruit teams and players to complete the field (we can take up to 12 teams) and to enjoy New Zealand's 1st excursion into the world of Over 60s Cricket.

Teams, individuals or groups of players are welcome and can be easily included in the Tournament. We are forming a couple of composite teams so if you do not have a team to play for just let us know and we will ensure you are placed in a team that will ensure your participation and enjoyment.
