# **AUCC 100 CLUB GUIDE**

### 1. Membership Benefits

- a. Each member has their own uniquely numbered AUCC beer handle for their own exclusive use.
- b. 100CLUB members pay the same price as a standard pint, but their handle glass is 18% larger (500ml vs 420ml), so handle club members get an effective discount of 15%.
- c. 100CLUB members can also receive a 10% discount on beer jug purchases.

#### 2. 100CLUB Events

- a. There will be at least one 100CLUB event in each calendar month of the season, and all members are invited.
- b. Wherever possible these events will be planned to coincide with a senior home game.
- c. A list of 100CLUB event dates will be posted in the clubrooms at the start of the season, and dates will be notified by email.
- d. There will be at least one cash draw at every 100CLUB event.

#### 3. 100CLUB Cash draws

- a. Cash draws will be conducted by randomly selecting a handle number to win.
- b. The member who has the winning handle number must be present in the clubrooms at the time of the draw in order to win.
- c. If the holder of the winning number is not present, then we will re-spin

## 4. Membership & Renewal

- a. Open to any AUCC member, including players, non-players & junior parents.
- b. Membership cost is \$100 per season
- c. Members have first option to renew their membership and retain their number at the start of each season.
- d. Renewal must be confirmed and paid before the 1<sup>st</sup> of October prior to the start of the season.
- e. Any handle numbers uncommitted on or after 1 October will be available for other club members to reserve.
- f. 100CLUB Members have an exclusive right to use their numbered handle, but do not own it. If membership lapses or is not renewed, the handle glass remains the property of the AUCC.
- g. No one else may use a 100CLUB members' numbered handle, it is for the members' exclusive use only.
- h. In the event that a 100CLUB member passes away, their number shall be retired and will not be available for any future member to use. All higher numbers will move 'up' one position on the board, and an additional numbered handle will be added at the bottom.
